## CRY OF THE EARTH/CRY OF THE POOR

Our Parish Pastoral Council responded very positively to the call of Pope Francis and of our Archbishop, Dr Dermot Farrell, for actions by Church Communities to the global climate change crisis. The eight large planters that frame the gathering space in front of our church have been planted with sustainable pollinator friendly plants; a simple visible sign encouraging us to change our domestic habits in favour of what is more sustainable. Many thanks to our parishioners who worked so givingly on this project.

A gigantic raffle was held in conjunction with a parish coffee morning on June 23rd. We raised €15,710.76 for the Mary's Meals Charity. It was founded in 2007 and provides daily meals and education to 2.5 million children in the poorest parts of the world severely impacted by climate change. 97 cent of every euro

raised goes directly to the charity. Our €15,710.76 is enough to feed and educate 714 impoverished children for a whole school year. We are most grateful for all the support from parishioners at the coffee morning. Thanks to all who sold and bought tickets, to the bakers who so generously provided the cakes and treats, to so many volunteers who helped making teas and coffees. Delighted to have had many musicians entertaining us. Wonderful too, that we had so many raffle prizes. Thanks to all the donors and congratulations to the many winners. Thanks to the Mary's Meals volunteers who were present for the raffle.
